Product Overview	Recombinant Human CENPJ protein, fused to GST-tag, was expressed in E.coli and purified by GSH-sepharose.

Description	This gene encodes a component of the chromosomal passenger complex. This complex is an essential regulator of mitosis and cell division. This protein is cell-cycle regulated and is required for chromatin-induced microtubule stabilization and spindle formation. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants. Pseudogenes of this gene are found on chromosomes 7, 8 and 16.
Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	1M PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 100mM GSH and 1% Triton X-100, 15% glycerol.
