Reconstitution

Dissolve the product in 200 µl sterile water to achieve a working concentration of 0.25 g/µl. If experimental compatibility allows, mix the aqueous solution with an equal volume of glycerol (1:1 ratio) after initial reconstitution.

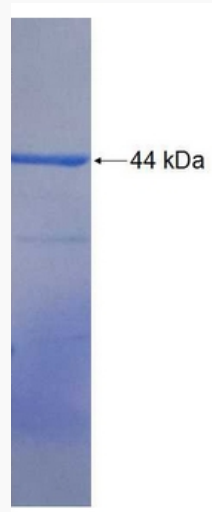
