Description	Enables complement binding activity and serine-type endopeptidase inhibitor activity. Predicted to be involved in negative regulation of complement activation, lectin pathway and negative regulation of endopeptidase activity. Predicted to act upstream of or within several processes, including complement activation, classical pathway; fibrinolysis; and negative regulation of peptidase activity. Located in extracellular space. Is expressed in several structures, including genitourinary system; neural ectoderm; notochord; pancreas mesenchyme; and visceral pericardium. Human ortholog(s) of this gene implicated in several diseases, including COVID-19; angioedema (multiple); cerebral infarction; pancreatitis; and toxic shock syndrome. Orthologous to human SERPING1 (serpin family G member 1).

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1 mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.
