Description	Predicted to enable bisphosphoglycerate 2-phosphatase activity and fructose-2,6-bisphosphate 2-phosphatase activity. Predicted to be involved in several processes, including fructose 1,6-bisphosphate metabolic process; negative regulation of cell death; and regulation of phosphate metabolic process. Predicted to act upstream of or within several processes, including intestinal epithelial cell development; negative regulation of catabolic process; and positive regulation of cardiac muscle cell apoptotic process. Predicted to be located in mitochondrial outer membrane and nucleus. Predicted to be active in cytosol. Orthologous to human TIGAR (TP53 induced glycolysis regulatory phosphatase).

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1 mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.
