Product Overview	Recombinant Human CD274 Protein extracellular domain N-terminal segment (NP_054862.1, 1-239aa), was expressed in Human Cell with C-terminal His tag and Alexa Fluor 555 conjugate.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant mature human B7-H1 comprises 232 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 26.8 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, the rh B7-H1 migrates as an approximately 35-38 kDa protein in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 555 via amines With an excitation and emission maximum of 555/565 nm, Alexa Fluor 555 can be efficiently excited using a 543 nm He-Ne laser line and detected under standard TRITC/Cy3 filters.

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Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
