Product Overview	A DNA sequence encoding the rat EPHA3 (EDL75897.1) (Met1-His541) (Alexa Fluor 555 conjugated) was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant rat EPHA3 comprises 532 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 61.2 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the recombinant protein is approximately 70.5 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 555 via amines With an excitation and emission maximum of 555/565 nm, Alexa Fluor 555 can be efficiently excited using a 543 nm He-Ne laser line and detected under standard

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	TRITC/Cy3 filters.
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH7.4.
Conjugation	Alexa Fluor 555
