Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 555 conjugated recombinant human ErbB4 (NP_005226.1) (Met1-Arg649), fused with a C-terminal polyhistidine tag, was produced in Human Cell.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human ERBB4 is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 635 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 71.1 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 102 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 555 via amines With an excitation and emission maximum of 555/565 nm, Alexa Fluor 555 can be efficiently excited using a 543 nm He-Ne laser line and detected under standard TRITC/Cy3 filters.

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Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution of sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
Conjugation	Alexa Fluor 555
