Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 555 conjugated recombinant human FGFR2 (NP_000132.3) cytoplasmic domain (Met 400-Thr 821), fused with the N-terminal polyhistidine-tagged GST tag, was produced in Baculovirus-Insect cells.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human FGFR2 (aa 400-821) /GST chimera consists of 659 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 75.7 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 68 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 555 via amines With an excitation and emission maximum of 555/565 nm, Alexa Fluor 555 can be efficiently excited using a 543 nm He-Ne laser line and detected under standard TRITC/Cy3 filters.

Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from 0.2 µm filtered solution of 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, pH 7.4, 10% gly
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
Conjugation	Alexa Fluor 555
