Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 555 conjugated recombinant human IDO1 (P14902-1) (Ala 2-Gly 403), fused with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus, was produced in E. coli.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human IDO1 consisting of 409 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 46 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 44 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 555 via amines With an excitation and emission maximum of 555/565 nm, Alexa Fluor 555 can be efficiently excited using a 543 nm He-Ne laser line and detected under standard TRITC/Cy3 filters.
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.

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Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile 50 mM Tris, 0.15M NaCl, 10% glycerol, pH 8.0
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
Conjugation	Alexa Fluor 555
