Molecular Mass	The recombinant human ERK2/GST chimera consists of 585 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 67 kDa as estimated in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 555 via amines With an excitation and emission maximum of 555/565 nm, Alexa Fluor 555 can be efficiently excited using a 543 nm He-Ne laser line and detected under standard TRITC/Cy3 filters.

Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile 50 mM Tris, 100 mM NaCl, 0.5 mM PMSF, 10% Glycerol, pH 8.0
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
Conjugation	Alexa Fluor 555
