Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 647 conjugated recombinant human ABL1 (NP_009297.2) amino acid sequence (Pro 137-Ser 554), fused with the GST tag at the N-terminus, was produced in Baculovirus-Insect cells.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human ABL1/GST chimera consists of 645 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 74 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 65 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 647 via amines Excitation = 650 nm Emission = 668 nm
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.

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Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile 50 mM Tris, 100 mM NaCl, 0.5 mM PMSF, 0.5 mM EDTA, 0.5 mM Reduced Glutathione, pH 8.0
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
