Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 647 conjugated recombinant human FAP (Q12884-1) isoform 1 extracellular domain (Leu 26-Asp 760), fused with the polyhistidine-tag at the N-terminus, was produced in Human Cell.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human FAP consists of 751 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 87.2 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, rh FAP migrates as approximately 90 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 647 via amines Excitation = 650 nm Emission = 668 nm
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.

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Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile 25 mM Tris, 250 mM NaCl, pH 8.2
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
Conjugation	Alexa Fluor 647
