Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 647 conjugated recombinant human MUC1 (NP_001018016.1) isoform 2 extracellular domain (Met 1-Gly 167), fused with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus, was produced in Human Cell.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human MUC1/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer consists of 376 amino acids after removal the signal peptide and has a predicted molecular mass of 42 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, rh MUC1/Fc monomer migrates as an approximately 55-60 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 647 via amines Excitation = 650 nm Emission = 668 nm

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Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
