Product Overview	Alexa Fluor 647 conjugated recombinant human NTRK1 (NP_002520.2) amino acid sequence (Pro 194-Glu 413) corresponding to the Ig-like C2-type 1 & 2 domains, fused with a N-terminal polyhistidine tag, was produced in Human Cell.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human NTRK1 Ig-like C2-type 1 & 2 domains (aa 194-413) consists of 239 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 26 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 45-50 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 647 via amines Excitation = 650 nm Emission = 668 nm

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Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
