Molecular Mass	The recombinant mouse EPHA3/GST chimera consists of 653 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 74.3 kDa. The recombinant protein migrates as an approximately 66 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

	Labeled with FITC via amines Excitation source: 488 nm spectral line, argon-ion laser Excitation Wavelength: 488 nm Emission Wavelength: 535 nm
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, 10% glycerol, pH 8.0. Normally 5%-8% trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
