Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit IL-13-dependent proliferation of TF-1 human erythroleukemic cells. The ED50 for this effect is typically 0.01 - 0.03 µg/mL in the presence of 8 ng/mL of recombinant mouse IL-13.
Molecular Mass	Recombinant Mouse Il13ra2, Fc Chimera has a calculated MW of 63 kDa (monomer). In SDS-PAGE migrates as 85-90 kDa, reducing conditions.
