Product Overview	FITC conjugated recombinant Mouse Parp1 (NP_031441.2) (Met 1-Trp 1014), fused with a polyhistidine tag at the N-terminus, was produced in Baculovirus-Insect cells.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant mouse PARP1 consists of 1033 amino acids and has a calculated molecular mass of 115 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 75 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with FITC via amines Excitation source: 488 nm spectral line, argon-ion laser Excitation Wavelength: 488 nm Emission Wavelength: 535 nm
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.

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Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from 0.2 µm filtered solution of 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, pH 8.0, 10% gly, 0.1 mM TCEP
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
