Product Overview	FITC conjugated recombinant human PDGFRA extracellular domain (Met 1-Glu 524) (NP_006197.1), fused with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus, was produced in Human Cell.

Molecular Mass	The recombinant human PDGFRα/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimeric protein after removal of the signal peptide. The reduced monomer consists of 739 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 82.9 kDa. By SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions, the apparent molecular mass of rhPDGFRα/Fc is approximately 120-130 kDa due to the glycosylation.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ μg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with FITC via amines Excitation source: 488 nm spectral line, argon-ion laser Excitation Wavelength: 488 nm

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	Emission Wavelength: 535 nm
Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
