Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Cpt1c Protein (Met589-Leu798) with His tag was expressed in E. coli.

Description	Predicted to enable carnitine O-palmitoyltransferase activity. Involved in regulation of postsynaptic membrane neurotransmitter receptor levels. Located in several cellular components, including dendrite; endoplasmic reticulum; and postsynapse. Is integral component of endoplasmic reticulum membrane. Part of AMPA glutamate receptor complex. Is active in glutamatergic synapse. Is expressed in several structures, including alimentary system; genitourinary system; heart; nervous system; and sensory organ. Human ortholog(s) of this gene implicated in hereditary spastic paraplegia 73. Orthologous to human CPT1C (carnitine palmitoyltransferase 1C).

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Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in PBS or others.
