Predicted to be involved in several processes, including positive regulation of ATPase activity; protein refolding; and regulation of cellular protein metabolic process. Predicted to be located in inclusion body; nuclear membrane; and perinuclear region of cytoplasm. Predicted to be active in cytosol. Predicted to be intrinsic component of endoplasmic reticulum membrane. Human ortholog(s) of this gene implicated in distal spinal muscular atrophy type 5. Orthologous to human DNAJB2 (DnaJ heat shock protein family (Hsp40) member B2).

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in PBS or others.
