Description	Predicted to enable chaperone binding activity; signaling receptor binding activity; and structural molecule activity. Predicted to contribute to cell adhesion molecule binding activity. Involved in cellular response to interleukin-1 and cellular response to leptin stimulus. Located in blood microparticle and cytoplasm. Biomarker of pancreatitis and pulmonary embolism. Human ortholog(s) of this gene implicated in cardiovascular system disease (multiple); congenital afibrinogenemia; and end stage renal disease. Orthologous to human FGB (fibrinogen beta chain).

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Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in PBS or others.
