Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Nox4 Protein (Gly210-Ser578) with N-His tag was expressed in E. coli.

Description	Enables protein tyrosine kinase binding activity and superoxide-generating NAD(P)H oxidase activity. Involved in several processes, including positive regulation of intracellular signal transduction; positive regulation of nitrogen compound metabolic process; and superoxide anion generation. Acts upstream of or within bone resorption; cardiac muscle cell differentiation; and cellular response to glucose stimulus. Located in several cellular components, including mitochondrion; nucleus; and perinuclear region of cytoplasm. Is expressed in embryo; heart; metanephros; renal cortex; and ventricle compact myocardium. Orthologous to human NOX4 (NADPH oxidase 4).

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	20mM Tris, 150mM NaCl, pH8.0, containing 1mM EDTA, 1mM DTT, 0.01% SKL, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in 20mM Tris, 150mM NaCl (pH8.0) to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

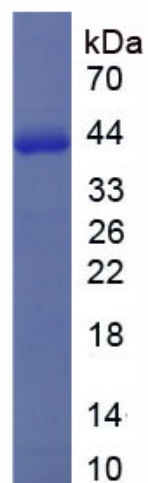
