Description	Predicted to enable identical protein binding activity and protein C-terminus binding activity. Involved in several processes, including animal organ development; response to cAMP; and response to hydrogen peroxide. Part of protein-containing complex. Used to study familial hyperlipidemia. Biomarker of myocardial infarction; obesity; and proteinuria. Orthologous to human SDC1 (syndecan 1).

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by

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accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

Storage

Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.

Storage Buffer

PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.

Reconstitution

Reconstitute in PBS or others.
