Product Overview	Recombinant Human GK5 protein, fused to GST-tag, was expressed in E.coli and purified by GSH-sepharose.

Description	The product of this gene is part of a large complex localized to the cytoplasm, nucleoli, and to discrete nuclear bodies called Gemini bodies (gems). The complex functions in spliceosomal snRNP assembly in the cytoplasm, and regenerates spliceosomes required for pre-mRNA splicing in the nucleus. The encoded protein directly interacts with a DEAD box protein and several spliceosome core proteins. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been described, but their biological validity has not been determined.
Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	1M PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 100mM GSH and 1% Triton X-100, 15% glycerol
