Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Invs Protein (Met1-Val239) with a N-His tag was expressed in E. coli.

Description	Predicted to enable calmodulin binding activity. Acts upstream of or within several processes, including animal organ development; epithelial cilium movement involved in determination of left/right asymmetry; and protein localization to ciliary inversin compartment. Located in ciliary base and ciliary inversin compartment. Is expressed in several structures, including adrenal gland; brain; gut gland; hemolymphoid system; and skeletal musculature. Used to study nephronophthisis 2 and tetralogy of Fallot. Human ortholog(s) of this gene implicated in nephronophthisis 2. Orthologous to human INVS (inversin).

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in PBS or others.
