Product Overview	Recombinant Human HPS1 protein, fused to His-tag, was expressed in E.coli and purified by Ni-sepharose.

Description	This gene encodes a protein that may play a role in organelle biogenesis associated with melanosomes, platelet dense granules, and lysosomes. The encoded protein is a component of three different protein complexes termed biogenesis of lysosome-related organelles complex (BLOC)-3, BLOC4, and BLOC5. Mutations in this gene are associated with Hermansky-Pudlak syndrome type 1. Multiple transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been identified for this gene; the full-length sequences of some of these have not been determined yet.
Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
Storage Buffer	1M PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 300mM Imidazole and 0.7% Sarcosyl, 15%glycerol.
