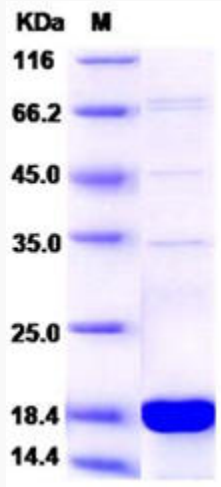
Product Overview	Recombinant Human SUB1 protein(P53999) (Met1-Leu127) was expressed in E.coli with a polyhistide tag at the N-terminus.
Species	Human
Source	E.coli
ProteinLength	1-127 aa
Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, 10% glycerol, pH 7.4.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant human SUB1 consists of 142 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 16.2 KDa. It migrates as an approximately 19 KDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C upon receiving. Recommend to aliquot the protein into smaller quantities for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
