Product Overview	A well-established source of cDNA-expressed enzymes for studies of metabolism.
Species	Human
Description	MAO B is distributed at high levels in the liver, brain and platelets. Benzylamine and phenylethylamine are considered selective substrate for MAO B. Deprenyl has been shown to be a potent and selective inhibitor and is currently used in the treatment of Parkinson's disease.
Form	100 mM potassium phosphate (pH 7.4) for MAO assays. When evaluating new buffers it may be advisable to test new compositions relative to the buffer used for the QC assay.
