Description	CD33 (CD33 Molecule) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with CD33 include Gallbladder Lymphoma and Extracutaneous Mastocytoma. Among its related pathways are Immunoregulatory interactions between a Lymphoid and a non-Lymphoid cell and Natural Killer Cell Receptors: Human Target Cell – NK Cell Ligand-Receptor Interactions. GO annotations related to this gene include receptor activity and carbohydrate binding. An important paralog of this gene is SIGLEC6.
