Product Overview	Recombinant full-length human UBE2J1 was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Description	UBE2J1 is a member of the E2 ubiquitin-conjugating enzyme family which is located in the membrane of the endoplasmic reticulum (ER) and may contribute to quality control ER-associated degradation by the ubiquitin-proteasome system. UBE2J1 is play an important role in the homeostatic regulation of MHC class I assembly and expression. HRD1 and UBE2J1 associate in a complex together with non-β2m bound MHC class I heavy chains, Derlin 1, and p97 and discriminate misfolded MHC class I from conformational MHC I-β2m-peptide heterotrimers.
Form	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5, 150mM NaCl, 0.25mM DTT, 0.1mM PMSF, 25% glycerol.
Molecular Mass	~70 kDa
Purity	>70% by densitometry
Applications	Western Blot
Storage	Store product at –70 centigrade. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller

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quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
