Product Overview	Recombinant full-length human UBA2 (SAE2) was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Description	UBA2 (SAE2) or ubiquitin-like modifier activating enzyme 2 forms a heterodimer that functions as a SUMO-activating enzyme for the sumoylation of proteins. The posttranslational modification of proteins by the addition of the small protein SUMO or sumoylation, regulates protein structure and intracellular localization. UBA2 functions in SUMO1 activation in a manner analogous to the single E1 ubiquitin-activating enzymes. The inactivation of UBA2 may be a therapeutic strategy in MYC-driven cancers.
Form	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.5, 50mM NaCl, 10mM glutathione, 0.1mM EDTA, 0.25mM DTT, 0.1mM PMSF, 25% glycerol.

Purity	>85% by densitometry
Applications	Western Blot
Storage	Store product at -70 centigrade. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller

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quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
