Product Overview	Recombinant full-length human UBE2G1 (UBC7) was expressed in E. coli cells using an N-terminal His tag.

Description	UBE2G1 (UBC7) or ubiquitin-conjugating enzyme E2G 1 is a member of the E2 ubiquitin-conjugating enzyme family and catalyzes the covalent attachment of ubiquitin to other proteins which are involved in degradation of muscle-specific proteins. UBC7 is highly expressed in skeletal muscle. UBC7 is involved in the selective ubiquitylation of different substrates by the same E3 complex.
Form	Recombinant protein stored in 50mM sodium phosphate, pH 7.0, 300mM NaCl, 150mM imidazole, 0.1mM PMSF, 0.25mM DTT, 25% glycerol.
Molecular Mass	~21 kDa
Purity	>95% by densitometry
Applications	Western Blot
Storage	Store product at –70 centigrade. For optimal storage, aliquot target into smaller quantities after centrifugation and store at recommended temperature. For most favorable performance, avoid repeated handling and multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
