Endotoxin	Less than 1 EU/μg of protein as determined by LAL method.
Purity	≥95% by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 - -80 °C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

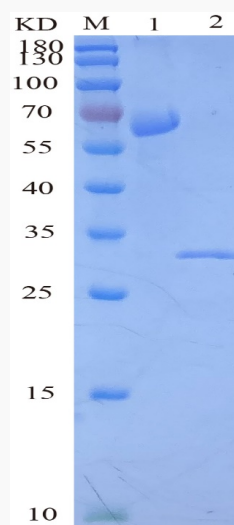
