Product Overview	Recombinant Active Mouse TNFSF13B Protein with His tag (C-ter) was expressed in E. coli.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a cytokine that belongs to the tumor necrosis factor (TNF) ligand family. This cytokine is a ligand for receptors TNFRSF13B/TACI, TNFRSF17/BCMA, and TNFRSF13C/BAFFR. This cytokine is expressed in B cell lineage cells, and acts as a potent B cell activator. It has been also shown to play an important role in the proliferation and differentiation of B cells. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been identified. Bio-activity	Determined by its ability to induce proliferation in mouse B cells. The ED50 for this effect is < 0.5 ng/mL. The specific activity of recombinant mouse BAFF is > 2 x 10 ⁶ IU/mg.

Endotoxin	Endotoxin level is less than 0.1 EU/μg of the protein, as determined by the LAL test.
Purity	> 98% (by SDS-PAGE)

Notes	For laboratory research only, not for drug, diagnostic or other use.
Storage	Lyophilized protein should be stored at -20°C. After reconstitution, aliquot and store at -20°C or -80°C for up to one month. Storage in frost free freezers is not recommended. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Suggest spin the vial prior to opening.
Storage Buffer	PBS (pH 7.4)
Reconstitution	It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized protein in sterile water to a concentration not less than 100 μg/mL and incubate the stock solution for at least 20 min at room temperature to make sure the protein is dissolved completely.

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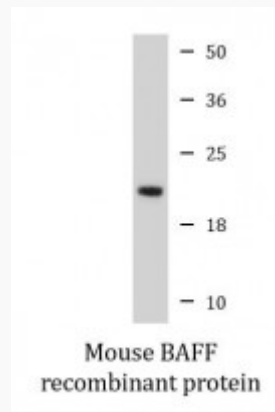
