Storage	Lyophilized protein should be stored at -20°C. After reconstitution, aliquot and store at -20°C or -80°C for up to one month. Storage in frost free freezers is not

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recommended. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Suggest spin the vial prior to opening.

Storage Buffer 20 mM Sodium citrate (pH 3.5) and 0.2 M NaCl.

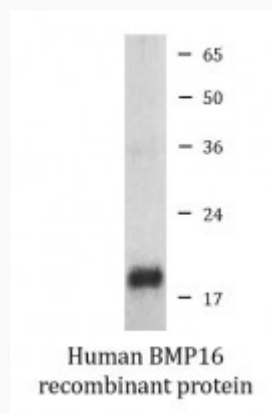
Reconstitution It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized protein in sterile water to a concentration not less than 100 µg/mL and incubate the stock solution for at least 20 min at room temperature to make sure the protein is dissolved completely.
