Product Overview	Recombinant human/mouse/rat/porcine NT-3 protein without tag was expressed in E. coli. Animal-free (AOF) and carrier protein-free. Mass spectrometry: single species with expected mass. Recovery from stock vial: >95%

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a member of the neurotrophin family, that controls survival and differentiation of mammalian neurons. This protein is closely related to both nerve growth factor and brain-derived neurotrophic factor. It may be involved in the maintenance of the adult nervous system, and may affect development of neurons in the embryo when it is expressed in human placenta. NTF3-deficient mice generated by gene targeting display severe movement defects of the limbs. The mature peptide of this protein is identical in all mammals examined including human, pig, rat and mouse.

Applications	Induced pluripotent and embryonic Stem cell Differentiation and maintenance

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Storage	Resuspend in 10mM HCl (Reconstitution solution A) at >100 µg/mL, prepare single-use aliquots, add carrier protein if desired and store frozen at -20 centigrade (short-term) or -80 centigrade (long-term)
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Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from acetonitrile/TFA

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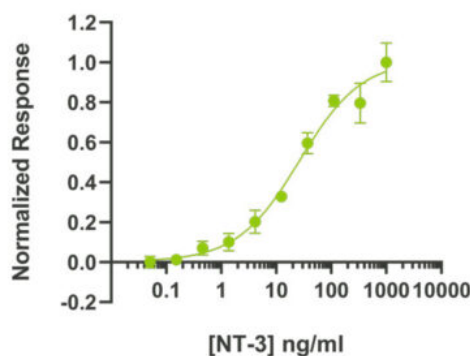

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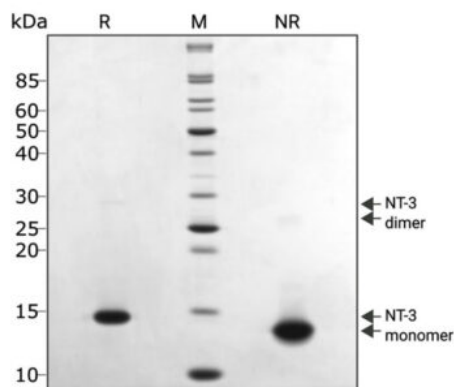
Bioactivity



The bioactivity of NT-3 is measured using a luciferase reporter assay in HEK293T cells co-transfected with the TrkA receptor.

Cells are treated in triplicate with a serial dilution of NT-3 for 3 hours. Firefly luciferase activity is measured and normalized to the control Renilla luciferase activity. EC50 = 23 ng/mL (0.84 nM)

Purity



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Human NT-3 migrates mainly as a single band at 13.7 kDa in non-reducing conditions and upon reduction (R). Purified recombinant protein was resolved using 15% w/v SDS-PAGE in reduced and non-reduced conditions and stained with Coomassie Brilliant Blue R-250. A faint band visible at 27.3 kDa in NR and R conditions, corresponds to the non-covalently linked NT-3 dimer. No contaminating bands are visible.

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
