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Stability	12 months from date of receipt when stored at -20 to -80 centigrade as supplied. 1 month when stored at 4 centigrade after reconstituting as directed. 3 months when stored at -20 to -80 centigrade after reconstituting as directed.
Storage	Storage Prior to Reconstitution: -20 centigrade
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from a sterile (0.2 micron) filtered aqueous solution containing 0.1% Trifluoroacetic Acid (TFA)
Reconstitution	Sterile 20 mM HCl at 0.1 mg/mL
Shipping	Room temperature
Instructions	Centrifuge vial before opening. Suspend the product by gently pipetting the above recommended solution down the sides of the vial. DO NOT VORTEX. Allow several minutes for complete reconstitution. For prolonged storage, dilute to working aliquots in a 0.1% BSA solution, store at -80 centigrade and avoid repeat freeze thaws.
