Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Interleukin-12 is produced by our Mammalian expression system and the target gene encoding Met23-Ser335&Arg23-Ala215 is expressed.

Description	IL-12 is involved in the differentiation of naive T cells into Th1 cells. It is known as a T cell-stimulating factor, which can stimulate the growth and function of T cells. It stimulates the production of interferon-gamma (IFN- γ) and tumor necrosis factor-alpha (TNF- α) from T cells and natural killer (NK) cells, and reduces IL-4 mediated suppression of IFN- γ . T cells that produce IL-12 have a coreceptor, CD30, which is associated with IL-12 activity. IL-12 plays an important role in the activities of natural killer cells and T lymphocytes. IL-12 mediates enhancement of the cytotoxic activity of NK cells and CD8+ cytotoxic T lymphocytes.
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 μ m filtered solution of PBS, pH7.4.
AA Sequence	Met23-Ser335&Arg23-Ala215
Endotoxin	Less than 0.1 ng/ug (1 EU/ug).
Purity	>95%

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Storage	Lyophilized protein should be stored at < -20 centigrade, though stable at room temperature for 3 weeks. Reconstituted protein solution can be stored at 4-7 centigrade for 2-7 days. Aliquots of reconstituted samples are stable at < -20 centigrade for 3 months. Always centrifuge tubes before opening. Do not mix by vortex or pipetting.
Reconstitution	It is not recommended to reconstitute to a concentration less than 100µg/ml. Dissolve the lyophilized protein in distilled water. Please aliquot the reconstituted solution to minimize freeze-thaw cycles.
Quality Statement	Purity: greater than 95% as determined by reducing SDS-PAGE.
Shipping	The product is shipped at ambient temperature. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature listed below.

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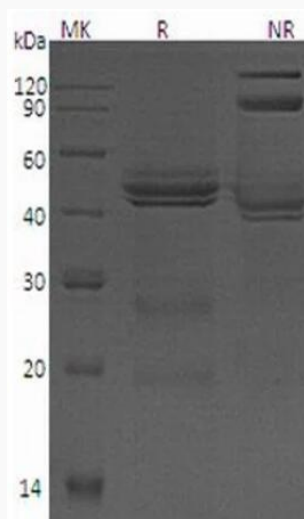
