Product Overview	Full-length recombinant human PCKT3 was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using an N-terminal GST tag.

Description	PCKT3 or PCKTAIRE protein kinase 3 is a member of the cdc2/cdkx subfamily of the ser/thr family of protein kinases. PCKT3 is thought to play a role in terminally differentiated neurons and it contains an N-terminal extension relative to CDC2. PCKT3 is expressed in a variety of human cell lines and tissues. Elevation in the protein levels of PCKTAIRE 3 in the temporal cortex of Alzheimer"s disease relative to control brains, have been observed. It is proposed that PCKTAIRE 3 is a paired helical filaments-associated kinase that modulates tau phosphorylation.
