Product Overview	Human TYK2, catalytic/pseudo-kinase domain [556-1187(end) amino acids of accession number NP_003322.3] was expressed as N-terminal DYKDDDDK tagged, biotinylated protein (76 kDa) using baculovirus expression system. The protein was purified by using DYKDDDDK tag antibody agarose.

Description	This gene encodes a member of the tyrosine kinase and, more specifically, the Janus kinases (JAKs) protein families. This protein associates with the cytoplasmic domain of type I and type II cytokine receptors and promulgate cytokine signals by phosphorylating receptor subunits. It is also a component of both the type I and type III interferon signaling pathways. As such, it may play a role in anti-viral immunity. A mutation in this gene has been associated with Immunodeficiency 35.

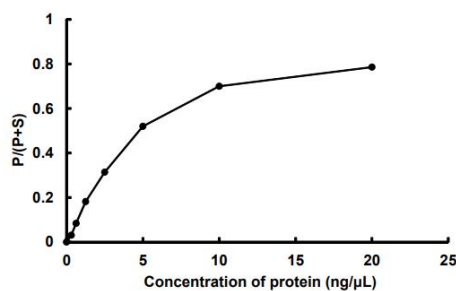
