Description	RANKL is an osteoclast differentiation and activation factor. Augments the ability of dendritic cells to stimulate naive T cell proliferation. Important regulator of interactions between T cells and dendritic cells and may play a role in the regulation of the T cell-dependent immune response. RANKL plays an important role in the progression of Breast cancer.
Form	Lyophilized. Contains PBS.
Bio-activity	Induces osteoclastogenesis of bone marrow-derived macrophages.
Molecular Mass	~55kDa (SDS-PAGE)
Purity	≥95% (SDS-PAGE)
Stability	Stable for at least 6 months after receipt when stored at -20°C.
Storage	Short Term Storage: +4°C; Long Term Storage: -20°C. After reconstitution, prepare aliquots and store at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles. PBS containing at least 0.1%
