Product Overview	The extracellular domain of human IL-4 (aa 1-153) is fused to the N-terminus of the Fc region of a mutant human IgG1.

Description	Interleukin-4 (IL-4) is a cytokine produced by type 2 helper T cells, the Th2 cells. These cells tends to make a specific set of lymphokines including IL-4, IL-5, IL-6, IL-10, IL-13, IL-3 and GM-CSF and fail to produce IL-2, IFN- γ , and lymphotoxin (TNF-beta). In addition, mast cells can produce IL-4. IL-4 exerts numerous effects on various hematopoietic cell types. On B cells, IL-4 promotes immunoglobulin class switching to IgE and IgG1 isotypes and upregulates MHC class II and CD23 expression. IL-4 promotes survival, growth, and differentiation of both T and B lymphocytes, mast cells and endothelial cells. In addition, IL-4 inhibits the production of TNF, IL-1, and IL-6 by macrophages.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2 μ m-filtered solution in PBS.
Bio-activity	Shows the biological function of the IL-4 moiety and exerts a prolonged circulating half-life caused by the modified Fc domain.
Purity	$\geq 98\%$ (SDS-PAGE)

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Stability	Stable for at least 1 year after receipt when stored at -20°C. Working aliquots are stable for up to 3 months when stored at -20°C.
Storage	Short Term Storage: +4°C; Long Term Storage: -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
