Product Overview	Mouse periostin (aa 24-783) (isoform 5) is fused at the C-terminus to a FLAG-tag.

Description	Periostin was originally isolated as an osteoblast-specific factor that functions as a cell adhesion molecule for pre-osteoblasts and is thought to be involved in osteoblast recruitment, attachment and spreading. Additionally, periostin expression has previously been shown to be significantly increased by both transforming growth factor beta1 (TGF-beta1) and bone morphogenetic protein 2 (BMP-2). Abnormal expression of Periostin is also linked to angiogenesis and metastasis in epithelial tumors.
Form	Lyophilized. Contains PBS.

Purity	≥95% (SDS-PAGE)
Stability	Stable for at least 6 months after receipt when stored at -20°C.
Storage	Short Term Storage: +4°C; Long Term Storage: -20°C. After reconstitution, prepare

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aliquots and store at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles. PBS containing at least 0.1% BSA should be used for further dilutions.

Concentration 0.1mg/ml after reconstitution.
