Description	In enzymology, a pyruvate oxidase (EC 1.2.3.3) is an enzyme that catalyzes the chemical reactionpyruvate + phosphate + O2 \rightrightarrows acetyl phosphate + CO2 + H2O2The 3 substrates of this enzyme are pyruvate, phosphate, and O2, whereas its 3 products are acetyl phosphate, CO2, and H2O2.
Form	Yellowish lyophilized powder.
Bio-activity	25~60 U/mg
Storage	Store in tightly closed containers, desiccated, protected from light, at -20oC.
