Product Overview	Human DKK1 /DKK-1 Protein, Biotinylated (Biotinylated DKK1) Thr 32 - His 266, was labeled with biotin based on rhDKK1 Protein, which was produced in human 293 cells (HEK293).

Description	This gene encodes a protein that is a member of the dickkopf family. It is a secreted protein with two cysteine rich regions and is involved in embryonic development through its inhibition of the WNT signaling pathway. Elevated levels of DKK1 in bone marrow plasma and peripheral blood is associated with the presence of osteolytic bone lesions in patients with multiple myeloma.?
Form	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in PBS, pH7.4. Normally Trehalose are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	Biotinylated DKK1, fused with 6×His tag at the C-terminus, has a calculated MW of 25.8 kDa. The predicted N-terminus is Thr 32 or Ser 35. DTT-reduced Protein migrates as 40 kDa due to glycosylation.
Endotoxin	Less than 1.0 EU per µg of the Biotinylated DKK1 by the LAL method.

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Purity	>95% as determined by reduced SDS-PAGE.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. No activity loss was observed after storage at: In lyophilized state for 1 year (4°C); After reconstitution under sterile conditions for 3 months (-70°C).
