Product Overview	Recombinant Human PHEX (Gln42-Trp749), fused with an N-terminal 6-His tag, was expressed in Sf 21 (baculovirus).

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a transmembrane endopeptidase that belongs to the type II integral membrane zinc-dependent endopeptidase family. The protein is thought to be involved in bone and dentin mineralization and renal phosphate reabsorption. Mutations in this gene cause X-linked hypophosphatemic rickets. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.

Form	Supplied as a 0.2 µm filtered solution in Tris and NaCl.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to cleave a fluorogenic peptide substrate, Mca-YVADAPK. The specific activity is >125 pmol/min/µg.
Molecular Mass	Predicted Molecular Mass: 83 kDaSDS-PAGE: 68-85 kDa, reducing conditions
Endotoxin	< 1.0 eu per 1 µg of the protein by the lal method

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Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by Colloidal Coomassie® Blue stain at 5 µg per lane.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 6 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70 °C as supplied. 3 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after opening.
