Description	Members of the ten-eleven translocation (TET) gene family, including TET3, play a role in the DNA methylation process.

Applications	Useful for the study of enzyme kinetics, screening inhibitors, and selectivity profiling.
Usage	Thaw on ice and gently mix prior to use. DO NOT VORTEX. Perform a quick spin before opening. Aliquot into small volumes and flash freeze for long term storage. Avoid multiple freeze/thaw cycles.
Notes	Avoid freeze/thaw cycles!

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Stability	At least 6 months at –80 centigrade.
Concentration	0.16 mg/mL
Storage Buffer	40 mM Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 110 mM NaCl, 2.2 mM KCl, 0.04% Tween20, 20% glycerol, 3mM DTT, 100 µg/mL FLAG peptide.
Shipping	At -80 centigrade.
