Description	The papain-like proteinase (PL-PRO) is responsible for the cleavages located at the N-terminus of replicase polyprotein. In addition, PL-PRO possesses a deubiquitinating/deISGylating activity and processes both 'Lys-48' and 'Lys-63' linked polyubiquitin chains from cellular substrates. Antagonizes innate immune induction of type I interferon by blocking the phosphorylation, dimerization and subsequent nuclear translocation of host IRF-3.

Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20 to -80 centigrade

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Storage

Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -80 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage Buffer

Supplied as sterile 50mM Tris-HCl (pH 7.5), 200mM NaCl, 20% glycerol

Shipping

It is shipped out with blue ice.
