Product Overview	GMP recombinant human M-CSF protein (Glu33-Ser190) with an N-terminal Met without tag was expressed in E. coli, produced using non-animal reagents in an Animal-Free laboratory and manufactured and tested under cGMP guidelines.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a cytokine that controls the production, differentiation, and function of macrophages. The active form of the protein is found extracellularly as a disulfide-linked homodimer, and is thought to be produced by proteolytic cleavage of membrane-bound precursors. The encoded protein may be involved in development of the placenta. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2011]
Form	Disulfide-linked homodimer
Bio-activity	Measured in a cell proliferation assay using M-NFS-60 mouse myelogenous leukemia lymphoblast cells. The ED50 for this effect is 0.5-1.5 ng/mL. The specific activity of Recombinant Human M-CSF is $>6.0 \times 10^7$ IU/mg, which is calibrated against the human M-CSF WHO International Standard.

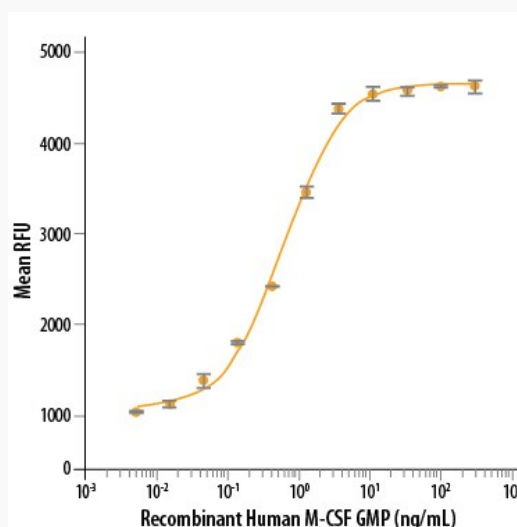

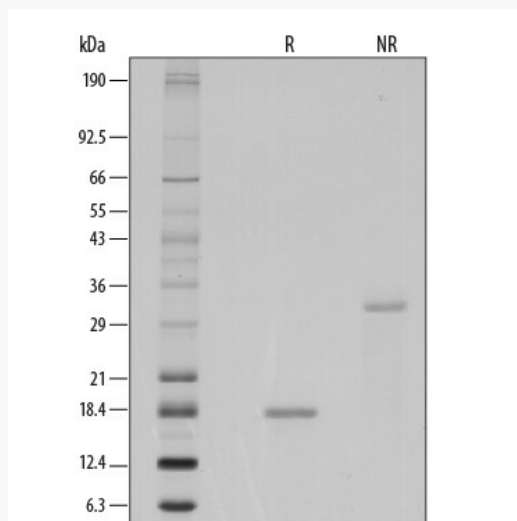


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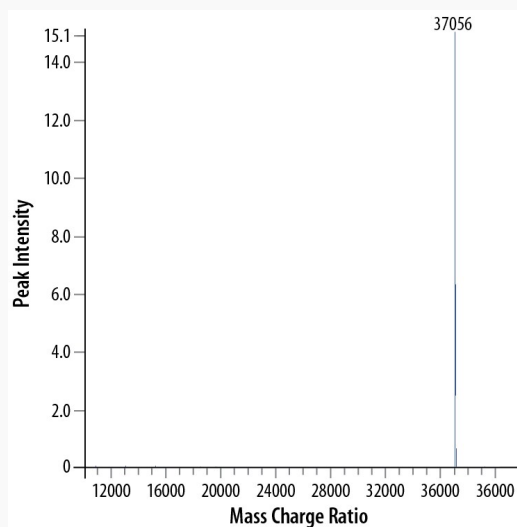
