Product Overview	Recombinant Human CCL28 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. MW = 14.3 kDa (126aa).

Description	CCL28, also known as chemokine (C-C motif) ligand 28 or mucosae-associated epithelial chemokine(MEC), belongs to the subfamily of small cytokine CC proteins. CCL28 is expressed by columnar epithelial cells in the gut, lung, breast and the salivary glands and drives the mucosal homing of T and B lymphocytes that express CCR10, and the migration of eosinophils expressing CCR3. This chemokine is constitutively expressed in the colon, but its levels can be increased by pro-inflammatory cytokines and certain bacterial products implying a role in effector cell recruitment to sites of epithelial injury.

Form	Liquid. In 10mM Sodium Citrate pH3.5 containing 10% Glycerol.
Purity	> 90% by SDS – PAGE.

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Concentration	1 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).
Endotoxin Level	< 1.0 EU per 1 µg of protein (determined by LAL method).
Storage	Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
